### ACTIVITY PACKS

Activity packs for the families who have chosen online learning will be available from Elvis from 9am on Monday morning. He is here from 8am - 4pm daily and you may collect your pack any time.

### PROTOCOL:

We will be enforcing the rules to keep everyone at Greenpark safe and so the following will apply -

- Parent questionnaire must be checked and responded to every morning(see attached)
- No entry without masks
- Temperatures taken on arrival(for everyone) and at hometime(for children)
- On entrance you will remove children's masks and visors will be available for every child.

- No parents will be allowed in the school grounds, other than to drop off their children.
- Hand washing using soap and at appropriately distanced basins will happen regularly during the day.
- Children will be assigned to a group or activity indoors or out.
- Hand washing will be encouraged after activities.
- Equipment will be cleaned after each use.
- Classes will be disinfected continuously throughout the morning and sanitized daily.
- Any child who appears unwell will be isolated and will need to be fetched at once.
- At home time, parents will queue on the pavement and your child will be handed to you at the gate.
- There is no need to send sanitizer to school with your child.

We have applied the above plan this week and it seems to work really well.
